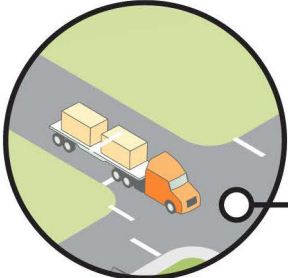


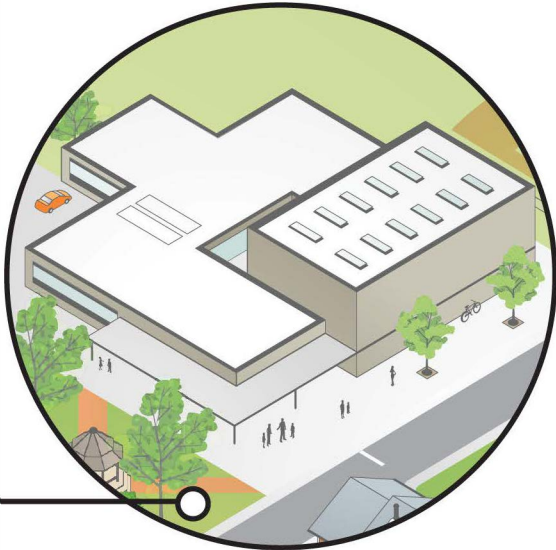
Federal Budget Cuts Are Hometown Cuts

Here's What Cities Stand to Lose in the Administration's Budget Proposal



Transportation and Infrastructure

- \$500 million for **TIGER grant programs**
- \$11 million for the **Brownfields Program**



Workforce Development & Education

- \$1.2 billion for **21st Century Community Learning Centers**
- \$1.341 billion for the **Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA)**
- \$231 million for **museums and libraries**

What Budget Cuts Would Mean For



Energy and Community Resilience

- \$220 million for the **Weatherization Assistance Program**
- \$1.4 billion for the **Office of Energy Efficiency and Renewable Energy**
- 25% reduction of **FEMA** assistance to cities



Community and Economic Development

- \$3.0 billion **CDBG**
- \$950 million for the **HOME Investment Partnership Program**
- \$221 million for the **Economic Development Administration**
